Communication could be a little better. Parents don't always receive a verbal message given to a 5 year old from a teacher. Emails are more effective please.

Would appreciate more feedback on how my child is doing if possible and more clubs / activities to be made available for Children in year 1.

My children have commented on how little time they are given to eat lunch (15 minutes). Within this time, they are also expected to go to the toilet wash their hands clear their lunch things away and be out on the playground by quarter past which leaves very little time available for them to physically eat lunch. Consequently, they regularly come home having eaten very little all day and when I ask them why it is the same response 'we didn't have enough time to eat'.

I can't see how my two children currently in the early stages of their school life could be getting a better education at this moment in time and this is before the exceptional extra-curricular teaching / opportunities kick in more fully in the coming years... I could not recommend the school highly enough... I have also witnessed first-hand the staff at work and their interactions with the children and was extremely impressed with the camaraderie I saw - there is clearly a strong unit in place.

I think Ickford school is a brilliant school and believes and drives the same values I would want instilled on my children... I respect their approach to education and cannot think of another institution that offers the same excellent service that they do. well done and keep it up!

My only suggestion would be that when teaching changes need to happen the parents with children in the class involved are kept updated. This would limit the gossip and make sure everyone had the same information.
