Although the children from Ickford go to a wide variety of Secondary Schools, Tim is the only Secondary Headteacher who offers to come in and talk about his vision for the school and I appreciate this.

We also have our own, new starter morning coming up soon when the children staring in September will come in and spend time in Class 1 whilst I meet with new parents. This is a very important meeting for me and Mme Basnett who joins me, because it enables time to clarify expectations with parents before they commit to the school. We always find that those parents whose children begin in Reception (EYFS) know what to expect and what they sign the Home School agreement for. This in turn makes for a positive long-term relationship.

We have been moderating the Early Years assessments this week and looking at the progress the youngest of our children have made. Mme Basnett described some of the evidence as 'insane' which is a fairly strong adjective and brought a big smile to Miss Vukomanovic's face. Personally, I never doubt Miss V's ability to create magic and I love to see the children's books and to hear them reading so well after what is a relatively short period of time. The year maybe coming towards its end but there is still plenty of time for more learning and more progress and I know Miss V will continue to provide an environment in which the children can flourish.
