Although our results are testament to the fact that we must be doing something right, I do not want to be complacent and at Ickford we are determined to keep on reflecting upon and evaluating what we do and the impact that it has on the children.

There are many comparisons between running the successful school and coaching the sports teams. The margins between success and failure are very small and one is constantly looking for ways to improve and to get an 'edge'. However, nothing is possible without talented team members and I am very pleased that I have plenty of these at Ickford.

There are some changes planned but more information about these will be released at a later date. In the meantime, let's keep supporting the children and ensuring they have the environment in which to thrive.
